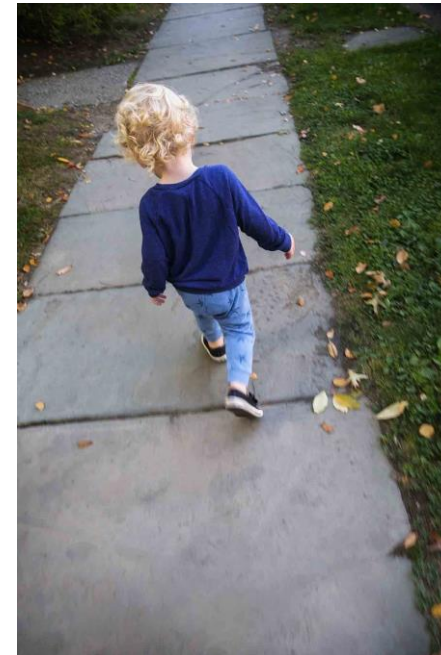




Stay on the Footpath
