Before we cross the road, we
STOP, LOOK, and LISTEN
for vehicles.



First,
we STOP walking.

Then we LOOK both
ways for vehicles:

We also Listen for Vehicles.



We listen for their motors.



If vehicles are moving,
we WAIT until they move away.



Or we wait for the driver to stop
and tell us it's okay.





If there are no vehicles moving,
we can cross the road.
