The WHO Regional Office for Europe is conducting an independent assessment of access to assistive technology in Ireland, by request from the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration of Youth. As part of this evaluation, it is very important to us that we hear directly from assistive technology users or their representatives.

Assistive Technology is defined by WHO as assistive products and their related systems and services. Assistive products help maintain or improve an individual's functioning related to cognition, communication, hearing, mobility, self-care and vision, enabling health, well-being, inclusion, and participation. In Ireland, some of these products may be referred to as aids and appliances.

Each is one hour, and will involve a 5 minute introduction to the evaluation process, followed by a guided discussion and open forum.
