## EAST LIMERICK CHILDREN'S SERVICES UPDATE

- East Limerick Children Services is operated by Avista in partnership with the HSE. We currently (28.02.2025) have 939 children accepted to our service.
- 763 children active.
- 176 children are currently on the waiting list. Approximate waiting time for start of service provision: 24 plus months
- Newly recruited: Senior Occupational Therapist 0-9 team, Senior SLT 9-18 team
- Current vacancies: Senior PT, Senior SLT, Basic Grade Psychologist, Senior Psychologist,
  1.75 Therapy Assistants, 1 Assistant Psychologist
- Maternity leave: Social Worker St Vincent Team until September 2025, upcoming: 2;
  Senior SLT and Senior OT
- Admin staff: 2 Clerical Officers, Administrator and CDNM; To support and ensure governance: Children Services Manager
