Meet Your Speech and Language Team

We have two full time and two part time speech and language therapists. Caitriona, Aine and Sarah work with children from babies up to 18 year olds and one of our full-time therapists, Nicole is currently on maternity leave.

Our speech and language therapists work with children to support and maximise their communication potential and increasing their quality of everyday life.

Speech and language therapists also have a role in working with you and your child to assess feeding, eating, drinking and swallowing (FEDS) skills. Following assessment of these skills, we will develop an individualized FEDS profile for your child which can be shared with your child's circle of support to continue to support this important area of development across environments.
