East Clare CDNT run postural care clinics: 24-hour postural care is a gentle, non-invasive, inexpensive way to promote health and quality of life for people with motor difficulties. It can protect the shape of a person's body, help balance muscle tone, reduce pain, ease physical care, improve sitting posture and tolerance, and help people sleep better

#### Overview of Clinic

- Joint Clinic with Physiotherapist and Occupational Therapist
- Physical assessment of body shape and range of movement of the joints
- Parent consultation to look at current equipment, activities of daily living and goals
- Moving and handling plan if needed
- Planning for equipment if needed
- Looking at your goals and priorities, and supports needed from the team
- Advice and education
