
## What are Social Stories?

Social stories are used to help children and young people understand social situations, expectations, social cues, new activities, and/or social rules.



## What are Comic Strip Conversations?

Comic Strip Conversations explore a child or young person's understanding of a social interaction. It involves drawing stick people with speech bubbles (to show what they said) and thought bubbles (to show what they may have thought).



When Matt says "How ya doing Dog?" he is inviting me into one of the guys. He is trying to be friendly. He is just joking around. He doesn't think I look like a dog. Next time I see him I'll smile and say, "How ya doing Dog?" to him.

## Why are they beneficial?

They are an extremely useful tool as many neurodivergent children and young people are visual learners.

They make social situations clear, predictable, and less overwhelming.

They are strengths-based and can help improve emotional regulation.
