I hope you are keeping well. My name is Aoife Ryan, and I am currently undertaking a PhD at Trinity College Dublin. My research is about **understanding** the **lives of children** and families living with **cerebral palsy** (CP) in Ireland – including what day-to-day life looks like, and what is most important to them.
